CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

I received my basic clinical experience following a one year and half year of pre-degree training period attending as an internal Medical Student in the Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Department , University Federico II of Naples, where my clinical knowledge improved. After completing my medical degree in 2010, I developed an early interest for Microsurgery assisting for Microsurgical reconstructions with Prof. Fabrizio Schonauer, which has been my Italian tutor.
